

## Microwaves Checklist:

It may be convenient having an extra refrigerator, but old, inefficient refrigerators can cost you well over \$10 a month in electricity. New refrigerators use up to 40% less energy compared to one built in the 1970's.

- A family using a microwave for most reheating and cooking may find the energy savings to be substantial.
- A microwave uses up to 50% less than a conventional electric stove.
- For large quantities of liquids, soups or stews, the stovetop element is twice as efficient as the microwave.
